Basic Board

\$1100

Grain 2-3x/day, New York hay 4x day, group or paired turnout. Stall cleaned 2x/day. Night check.
(Not currently available.)

Full Care Board

\$1500

Amenities of basic board plus:

Supplements fed, all meds administered (cost of meds, materials, & any special needs like syringe mix and given orally at additional fee), feet picked/shoes checked (1-2x day). Daily grooming plus regular bathing* as needed. Basic mane pull/trim as needed. Wet feed/mash as needed. Individual or paired turnout. Unlimited blanket changes. Laundry service (saddle pads, towels, and wraps only; blankets are extra). Schedule, manage, and hold for vet/farrier. Bandaging/poultice legs/packing feet. (Owner provides poultice and hoof packing or additional fee). Daily fly spray in summer. (Owner supplies spray). Fly mask on/off. Daily night check including late blanket changes as needed for inside horses, additional hay (and also tea/mash in inclement weather and during temperature swings). *Full care board must be accompanied by a training package.

Consignment Board

\$1950

Amenities of full care board, plus 20 rides per month. Horses will receive training rides and be used in lessons to prove themselves and what they are able to be appropriately marketed for. 15% commission paid to barn at conclusion of sale or training end date. *If a sales horse is too green to be used for lessons, the package will be upgraded to full training/full care at \$2500/mo. 15% commission at conclusion of sale or training end date.

Partial Training

\$600

One lesson and one training ride per week (no carryovers). *owners must be hacking 2+ additional times/week to be eligible or the package will be upgraded to full.

Full Training

\$1000

Up to 20 rides/month and/or up to 3 lessons/week (no carryovers). Training rides include a mixture of groundwork (especially on inclement weather days), riding, and lunging/round pen work as needed to suit the horse's individual requirements. Show riders must be on full training package. No makeups if you elect not to join us at a show.

A La Carte

- Lesson \$100 (only offered as add-on to training package or during 30 day intro period)
- Training Rides \$85
- Ship in private lesson \$115
- 60 minute horse assessment \$165
- Ship In rides \$100
- Longeing \$25 (included in full care at shows)
- Horse use fee \$40
- Board daily \$85
- Professional Photography package (one time fee for Consignment Horses) \$250
- Local Field trip (Young Horse Program) \$150-\$250

- Hauling:
 - Local Hauling minimum (Per horse min/hook up fee per) \$85
 - Singles \$2.25 loaded mile \$1.25 unloaded
 - Emergency or after hours fee: \$100
 - Horse show hauling. \$1.75/mi (2 or more, above minimum of \$85 per haul).
 - *plus possible fuel surcharge

Horse Show Fees:

- Prep and packing fee per horse per show. \$50 locals/ \$85 A's, per horse.
- Daily Coaching: \$150/horse for two. \$100/day three or more. (\$300/day for one)
- Full Day Care: \$120/day per horse includes bathing, unbraiding, longeing, tack up, wrapping legs, stall care, feeding, medicating, tack cleaning, hand walking/ grazing.
- Partial Day Care: \$60/day per horse includes stall cleaning, feed, water. (if any additional services are needed/ provided, clients will be upgraded to Full Day Care)
- Show riding: Local \$100/day, A's- \$150/day
- Legend: \$115
- Adequan: \$500/year
- Tack/Groom stall \$ client split
- Golf Cart \$ client split
- Trainer/Groom Hotel/meals/expenses \$ client split
- Horse show deposits may be billed prior to the show (depending on where we are in the billing cycle). The amount will be based on barn prepayment for show related expenditures and split among clients attending. Deposits are non-refundable and hold your spot for the show.
- Regulated and restricted show medications will be supplied by Hidden Hill Farm and administered/ supervised by a trainer, within the legal guidelines of our governing body, The United States Equestrian Federation (USEF). Approximate daily cost of meds: \$15-25
- Braiding \$140/ day manes and tails (tails are only required for classics and finals). Braids are to be removed daily for the well-being and comfort of the horse.
- 10% CC processing fee applied to all quickbooks transactions for horse shows

Horse Purchase and Sale Fees:

Standard 15% commission on all purchases, leases, and sales (due immediately upon completion of sale).

\$500 day fee (for each trainer shopping with you) which will be deducted from the commission at the completion of your sale. Client is responsible for all trainer travel, lodging, food and other related expenses including but not limited to purchasing videos of potential purchases for research purposes.

Average costs of outside services for budgeting purposes (listed services are required on an as-needed basis determined by your trainer and pro-rider):

Farrier \$200-250/4-5 weeks

Vet \$300 quarterly (vaccines, coggins, and basic standard vet care; joint injections \$250-600, dental float \$120)

Massage/body work \$90-120/session

Chiro \$110/session

PEMF \$120/session

BEMER treatment \$50/session

Braiding \$300/show

*Due to unprecedented rising costs, many of our suppliers have added fuel surcharges and additional fees which we are doing our best to keep up with. Additional services (laser treatment, joint injections, water therapy, etc.) may be required and will be approved by the owner prior to service.

HHF Lease Packages when available:

- \$2500 full lease plus all care and annual lease fee (varies per horse)
 - Up to 3 lessons/week and/or up to 20 training rides per month, unlimited hacks (to be scheduled in advance); specific horse guaranteed (substitute horse possible in case of temporary lameness/issue at \$35/use when available)
 - Leaser responsible for all of their horse's care, including but not limited to extra supplements required, vet, chiro, farrier, & pemf
 - Leaser must supply all tack and supplies - saddle to be cleared by trainer/saddle fitter
- \$2100 half lease plus half (or all if horse is not co-leased) and annual lease fee; if horse is co-leased, monthly half lease reduced to \$1550 (riders alternate shows, weekends and select standing days during the week).
 - 1 lesson/week, 1 training ride/week, and 1 hack (to be scheduled in advance); specific horse guaranteed (substitute horse possible in case of temporary lameness/issue at \$40/use when available)
 - Leaser responsible for half or all of their horse's care, including but not limited to extra supplements required, vet, chiro, farrier, & pemf
 - Leaser must supply all tack and supplies - saddle to be cleared by trainer/saddle fitter
 - Minimum six month commitment.

Notes:

*Statements are past due after the 5th of the month and will receive a \$100 late fee after that date.

*Anything over 30 days past due results in an automatic suspension of services and an additional 20% late fee.

*3% fee on credit card transactions; horse show fees will incur a 10% convenience fee for processing through quickbooks

*Industry standard groom tips (\$30/day/horse) will be automatically added to your invoice if you are an out of town client or not at the show on Sunday.
